Ensure appropriate fire safety measures and procedures are applied at all times for the safety of persons on the premises in the event of an outbreak of fire



#### We ensure welfare protection

Preventive measures improve aspects of pregnancy that may affect work. The Maternity Protection Act provisions entitlements are understood.

The HSA takes complaints from employees if an employer has not undertaken a risk assessment or provided a safety statement.

Safety Squad keep you safe from such actions.

Pregnancy is a part of normal everyday life; it is not an illness. Many women work during pregnancy and many return to work while they are breastfeeding. Because there are some hazards in the workplace which may affect either the health of the woman or her developing child, an employer has specific responsibilities. Become part of your Safety Squad

As the earliest stages of pregnancy are the most critical ones for the developing child, it is in the employee's interest to let her employer know she is pregnant as soon as possible. We help you do the right things. Regulation 24 requires an employer to ensure that affected employees are able to lie down to rest in appropriate conditions.
