

## **Code of Conduct**

DANAI operates under a Strict Code of Conduct. All Members must sign the Code of Conduct as part of the Membership Application process. Once Membership has been agreed then members are entitled to display the DANAI Charter Mark, Membership Certification and Charter Mark Certificate in their clinic.

## Members of the DANAI agree to:

- Provide nursing care that is in accordance with An Bord ALtranais and maintain professional registration.
- To have up to date, current and appropriate Professional Indemnity Insurance covering aesthetic and dermatology treatments
- Be accountable for their own actions and the care they provide, underpinned by the ethical principle, working within their professional code of conduct and scope of practice.
- To practice through continued professional development and evidence-based lifelong learning and underpin all practice with evidence-based knowledge
- Place the people they provide service to at the heart of the care they provide, without commercial bias, considering the person's dignity, humanity and equality, through compassionate and individualised care planning, that is based upon the person's needs and requirements.
- Ensure that people in their care are empowered in decision-making by providing full information of the treatment choices available, including the risks and benefits, allowing people to make fully informed decisions.
- Recognise that communication, communications skills, and confidentiality are vital components of the aesthetic care they provide.
- Promote and apply a continuous approach to risk assessment and management for the safety of people within the aesthetic healthcare setting.
- To have up to date, current and appropriate Professional Indemnity Insurance covering aesthetic treatments that can be made available to patients and DANAI if requested.
